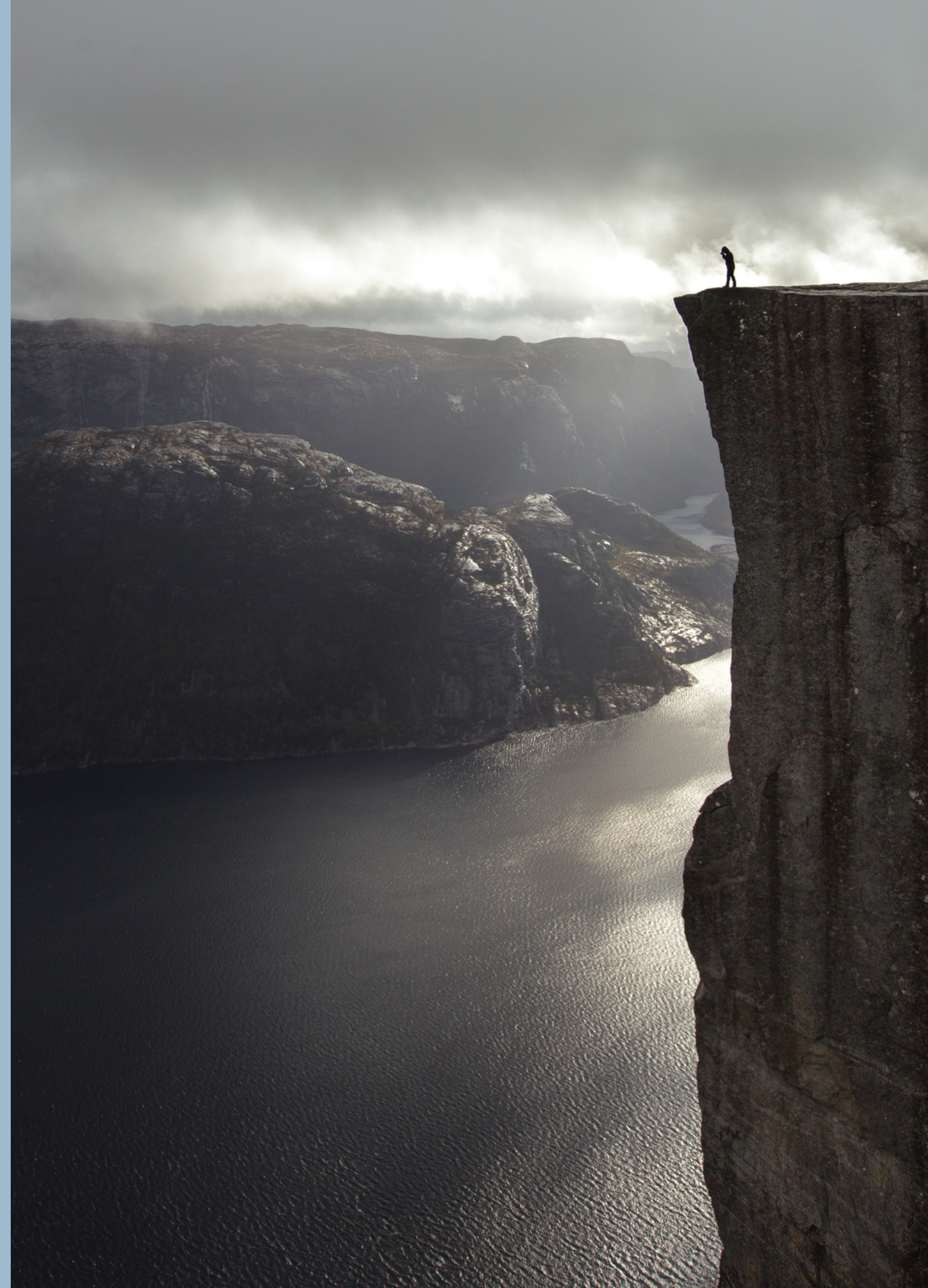
A LIFE OF IMPACT

1. TURN FROM WHAT'S EVIL

HOW DOES SIN AFFECT US?

1. Sin **deprives** us of spiritual strength and comfort.
2. Sin **weakens** the soul and deprives it of its strength.
3. Sin becomes the delight of the **heart**.
4. Sin becomes the meditation of our **minds**.
5. Sin **hinders** our spiritual walk
6. Sin **darkens** the soul

For the eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are **fully committed** to him.

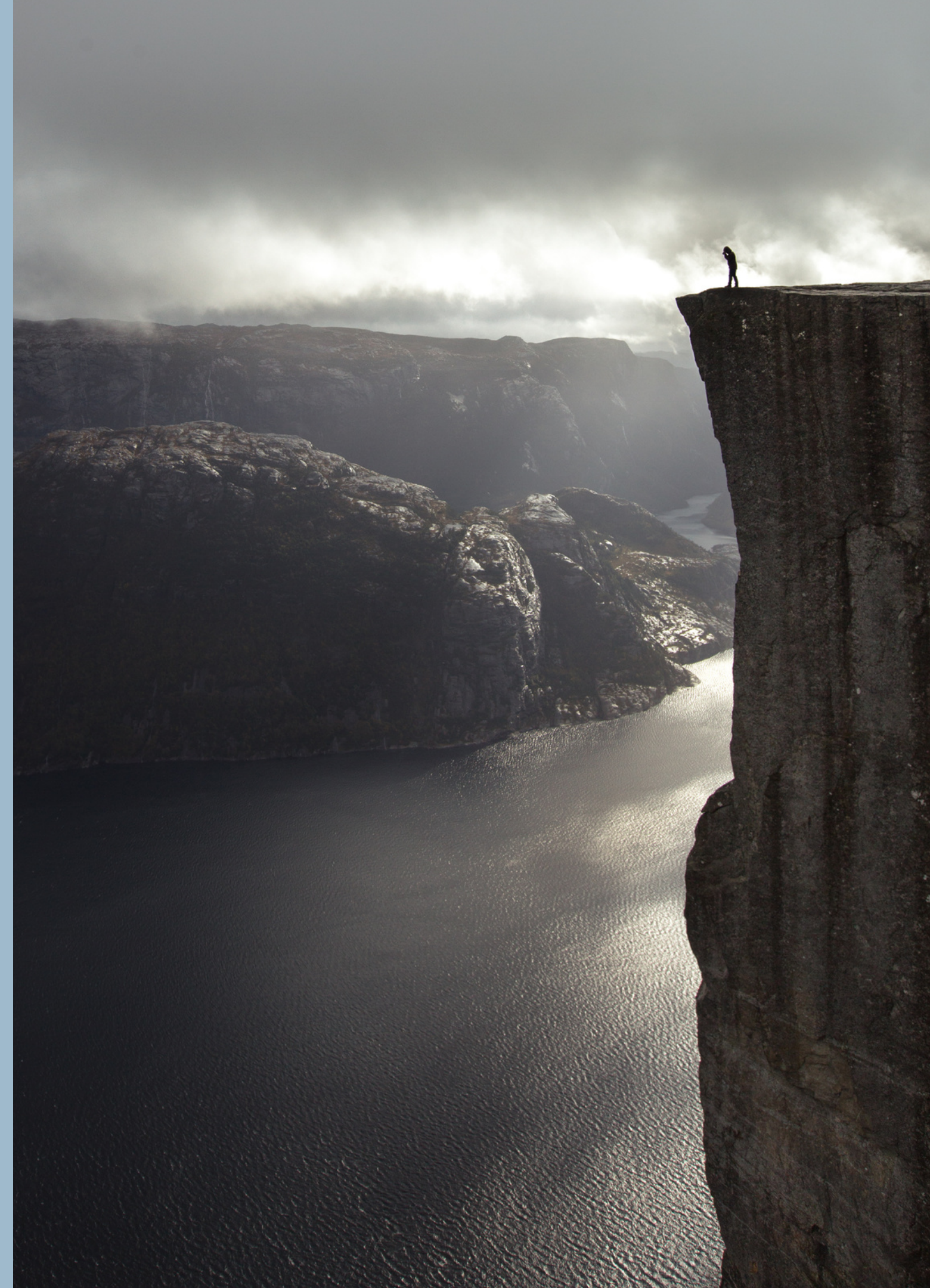

(1) God, (2) God's Word, and (3) the sould of men

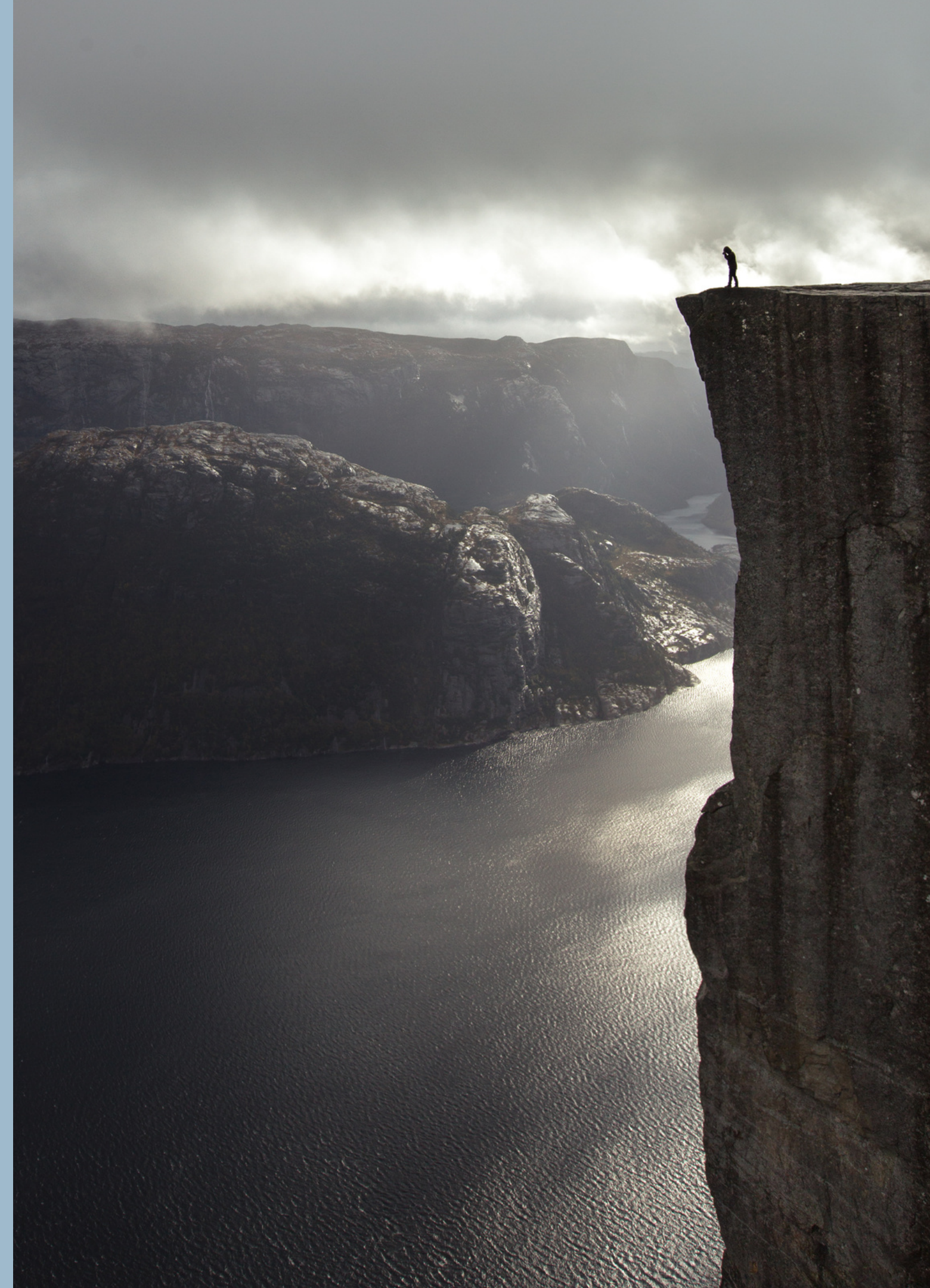


3. DO IT BY CHRIST'S POWER

"To whom will you compare me? Or who is my equal?" says the Holy One. Lift your eyes and look to the heavens: Who created all these? He who brings out the starry host one by one, and calls them each by name. **Because of his great power and mighty strength, not one of them is missing.**

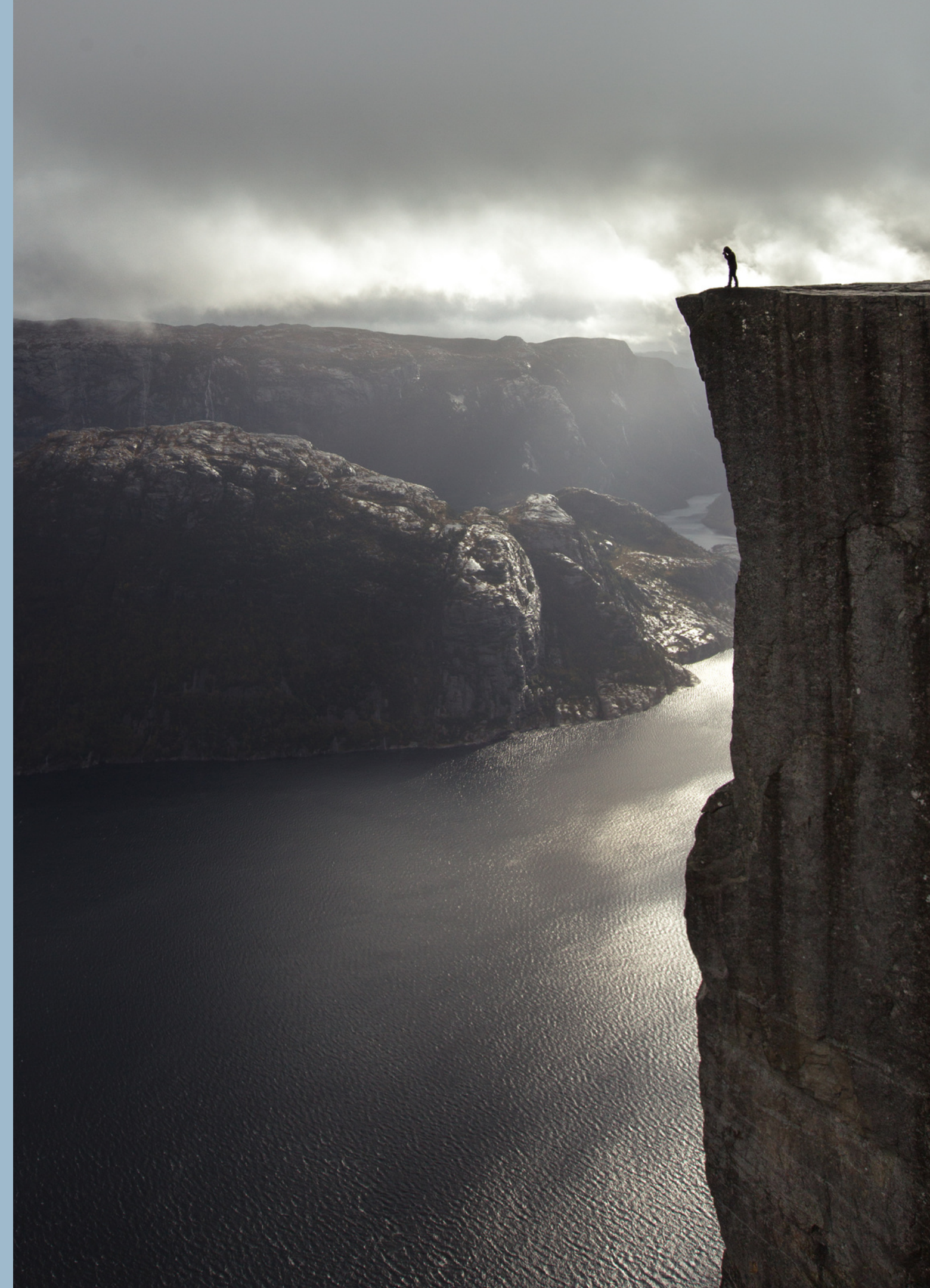

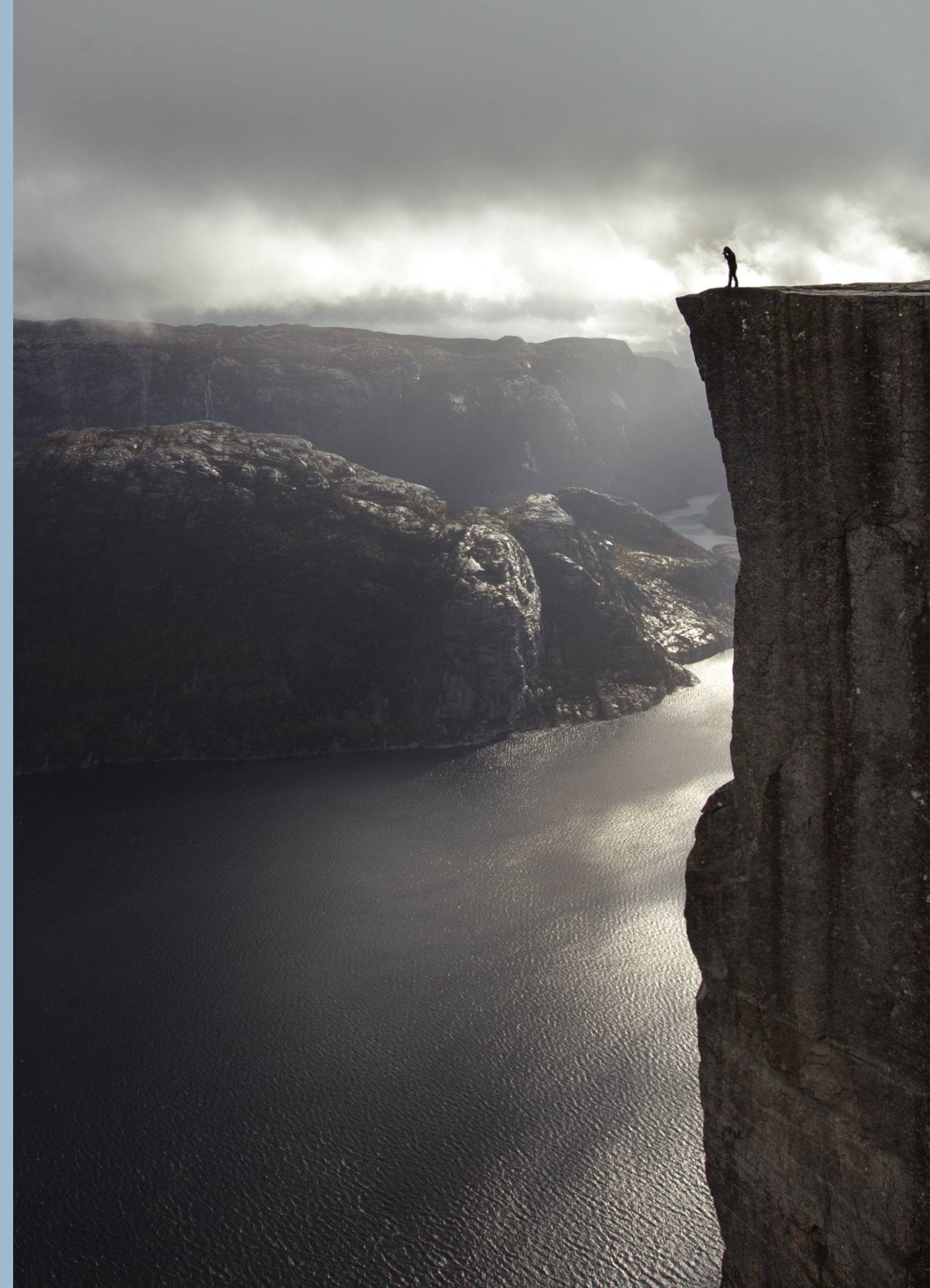
