God's Call, Gifts, and the Equipping of the Saints!

"And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers, ¹² for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ; ¹³ until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ." (Ephesians 4:11-13)



- I) "For the Equipping of the Saints!" (Ephesians 4:12)
- 1) "for the work of service"
- 2) "to the building up of the body of Christ"
- 3) "until we all attain to the unity of the faith"
- 4) "and of the knowledge of the Son of God"
- 5) "to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ" (Ephesians 4:12-13)



- II) Calling: "For the Work of Service!" (Ephesians 4:12)
- "Jesus replied, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God." (Luke 9:62)
- "constantly bearing in mind your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the presence of our God and Father," (1Thessalonians 1:3)
- "Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent." (John 6:29)
- "Jesus *said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me and to accomplish His work." (John 4:34)

- III) Gifts: "Christ gave gifts to men!" (Ephesians 4:11; Romans 12:1-21; 1 Corinthians 12:7-10)
 - "So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers," (Ephesians 4:11)
 - "We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; ⁷ if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; ⁸ if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully." (Romans 12:6-8)
 - "To one there is given through the Spirit a message of wisdom, to another a message of knowledge...,⁹ to another..., to another gifts of healing...,¹⁰ to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues." (1 Corinthians 12:7-10)



IV) Some Wisdom for the Road!

- 1) Remember that gifts are for the purpose of God's calling to build up the Church individually and corporately (Ephesians 4:12)
- 2) Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment (Romans 12:3)
- 3) The fruit of the Spirit is a priority over the gifts of the Spirit! (1 Corinthians 13:1-3)

4) Become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ (Romans 12:9-21; 1Thessalonians 1:5)



- 5) Exercise your gifts, but imitate other gifted people (2 Timothy 4:5)
- Appreciate and value less prominent and less visible gifts (1 Corinthians 12:6-8)
- 7) Honor and respect God-ordained gifts and offices for the leadership of the Church (Ephesians 4:12; Romans 1:5; Hebrews 13:17)
